We confess that our endurance in matters of faith has not fully been developed. We have been lax in training ourselves spiritually, and we have found ourselves more exhausted than strengthened by choosing to pursue our culture's pace instead of your peace.

Forgive us, we ask. Guide us, we pray. As we pray in the name of Jesus Christ. Amen
